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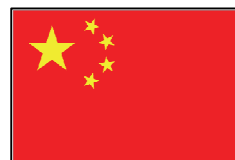

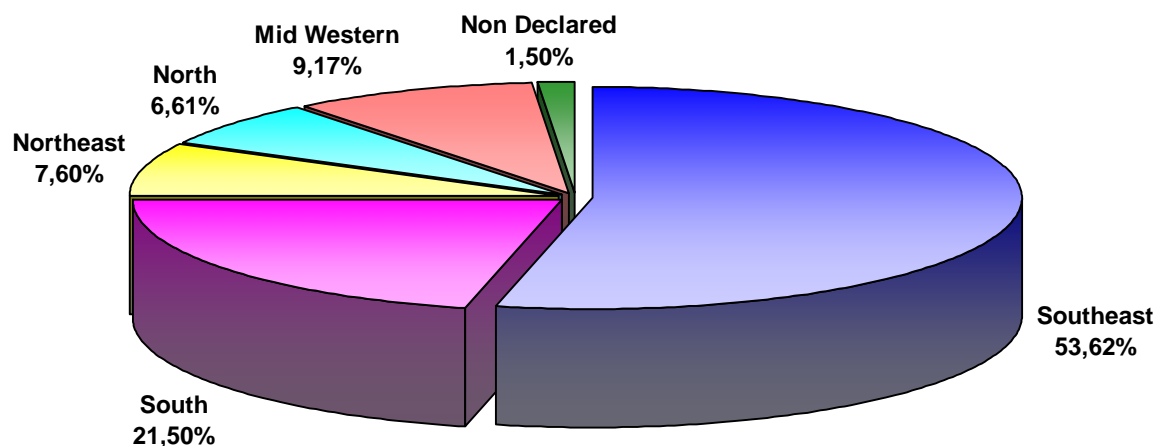

**Brazilian Exports by Regions in 2009**



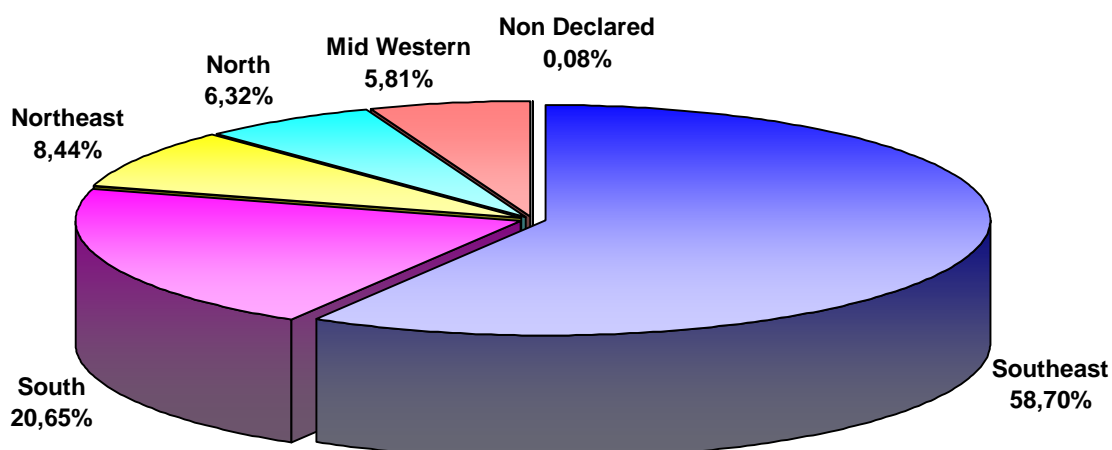

**Brazilian Imports by Region in 2009**

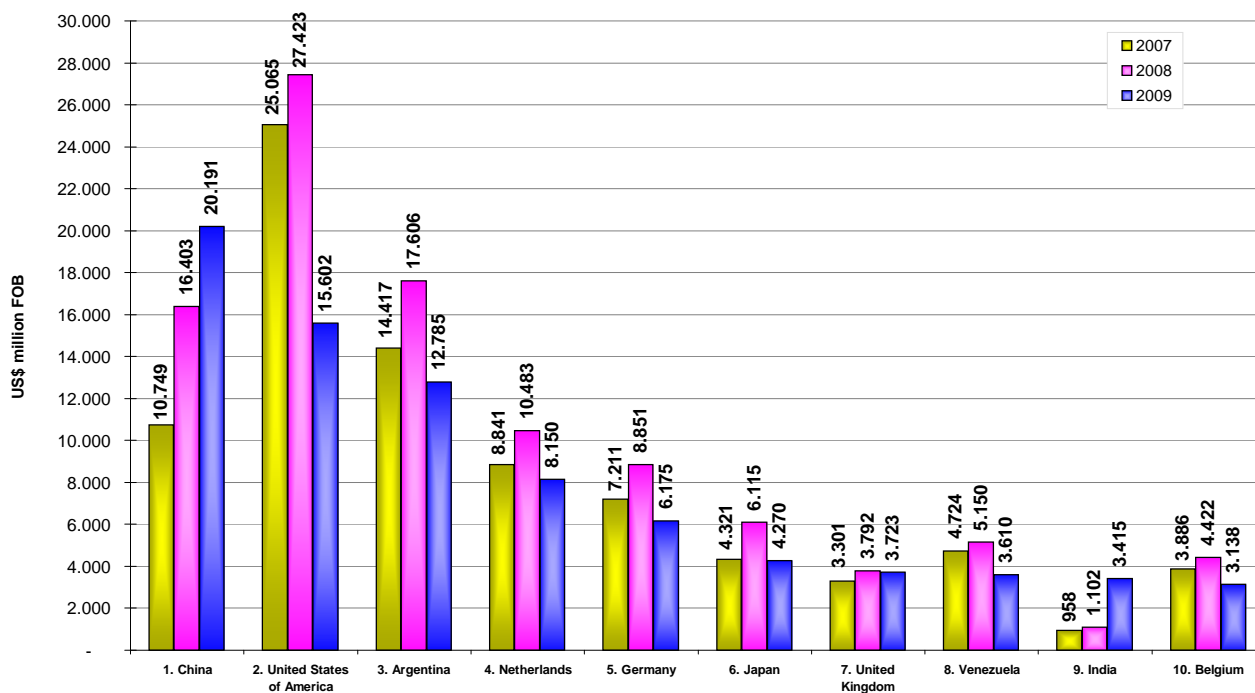

Foreign Trade Direction - Exports

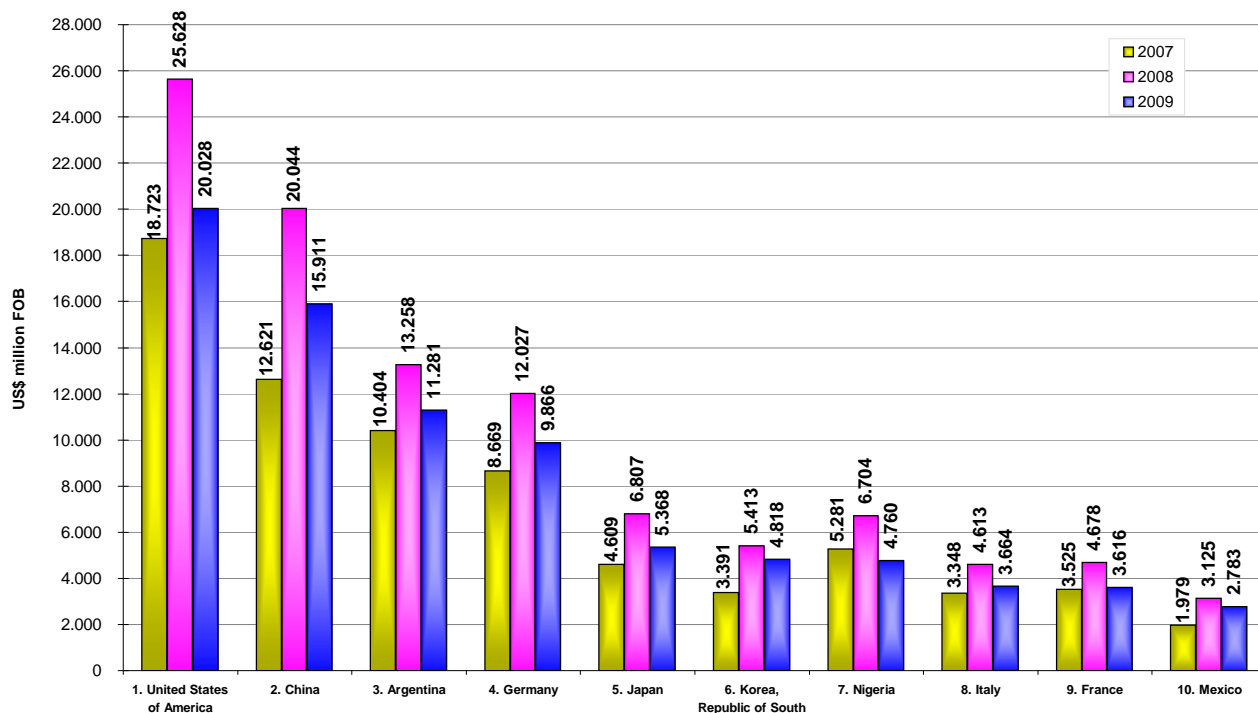
